

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement
between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the City of Glendale)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-016

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **Negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation ("Nation") with Federal, State, and local governments."**
4 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council previously approved a Mutual**
6 **Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement between the Tohono O'odham**
7 **Nation and the City of Glendale by Resolution No. 15-091; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation desires to renew the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement**
9 **Agreement ("Agreement") with the City of Glendale for a term of three (3) years**
10 **beginning on the date the last party signs the Agreement attached hereto ; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Agreement requires a limited waiver of sovereign immunity because it**
12 **requires the Nation to indemnify the City of Glendale; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the**
14 **Agreement, and recommends its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
16 **approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement agreement between the**
17 **City of Glendale and the Tohono O'odham Nation for the purpose of providing**
18 **assistance services for the Nation's Police Department servicing the West Valley**
19 **Casino, substantially in the form attached hereto.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the limited**
21 **waiver of sovereign immunity in the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement**
22 **Agreement that requires that the Nation indemnify the City of Glendale under**
23 **certain circumstances.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation's Chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute this**
26 **agreement, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for further prior**
27 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
29 **day of JANUARY, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
32 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
34 **(48 Stat.984).**
