

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Supporting Dr. Felina Cordova-Marks' "Urban American Indian Caregivers: Cancer and Non-Cancer Caregivers" Research Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-051

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,**  
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**  
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Felina Cordova-Marks, DrPH, MPH, a member of the Hopi Tribe, presented her**  
6 **research proposal "Urban American Indian Caregivers: Cancer and Non-Cancer**  
7 **Caregivers" to the Health and Human Services and Human Resources**  
8 **Development Committees for support; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the research will aim to "provide an understanding of the caregiver experience**  
10 **among urban American Indian caregivers" by surveying members of an**  
11 **American Indian/Alaska Native tribe providing care to a family member who has**  
12 **cancer, a chronic health condition, disability, or who is elderly, in Tucson or**  
13 **another urban area; and**

14 **WHEREAS, while all of Dr. Cordova-Marks' research will be conducted in urban areas outside**  
15 **of Nation's lands and therefore does not require approval pursuant to the**  
16 **Nation's Research Code, the Health and Human Services and Human Resources**  
17 **Development Committees recommend supporting Dr. Cordova-Marks' research**  
18 **by resolution.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports Dr.**  
20 **Cordova-Marks' "Urban American Indian Caregivers: Cancer and Non-Cancer**  
21 **Caregivers" research proposal and encourages Dr. Cordova-Marks to present the**  
22 **results and recommendations to the Legislative Council upon conclusion of the**  
23 **research.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>**  
25 **day of FEBRUARY, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**  
26 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
