

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Tribal Opioid Response Grant Program Supplemental Award and Approving FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 20-052

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Behavioral
8 Health Tribal Opioid Response Grant Program Budget in the amount of
9 \$504,591.00 was approved by Resolution No. 19-426; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation received a supplemental notice of award from the
11 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental
12 Health Services Administration ("SAMHSA") for the Tribal Opioid Response Grant
13 Program in the amount of \$193,445.00; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
15 review and approval its FY 2020 Division of Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid
16 Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this
17 reference and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Behavioral
19 Health Tribal Opioid Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase
20 the FY 2020 Division of Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid Response Program
21 Budget by \$193,445.00 from \$504,591.00 to \$698,036.00; and

22 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
23 reviewed the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of
24 Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1
25 and recommend its approval.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the
27 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental
28 Health Services Administration Tribal Opioid Response Grant Program
29 Supplemental Award.

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2020
31 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Tribal
32 Opioid Response Program Budget Amendment No. 1 effective September 30, 2019,
33 which includes a \$193,445.00 increase from \$504,591.00 to \$698,036.00 that shall

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1 be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the
2 grantor, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and
3 Mental Health Services Administration.

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
5 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
6 expend the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of
7 Behavioral Health Tribal Opioid Response Program Budget as amended,
8 provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior
9 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH
11 day of FEBRUARY, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,308.7 FOR;
12 867.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
13 by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted
14 by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
15 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
16 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
