

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2021 Department of Health and Human Services Office for Victims**  
**of Crime Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-124**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and received the U.S. Department of**  
8 **Justice Office for Victims of Crime ("OVC") Victim Services Set-Aside Program**  
9 **grant award in the amount of \$786,329.00 for the period of April 15, 2019 to April**  
10 **14, 2022, which was accepted by Resolution No. 19-338; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for**  
12 **review and approval its FY 2021 OVC Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget,**  
13 **which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$279,360.00 to be**  
14 **funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S.**  
15 **Department of Justice; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have**  
17 **reviewed the FY 2021 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim**  
18 **Services Set-Aside Program Budget and recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
20 **FY 2021 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim Services Set-Aside**  
21 **Program Budget, effective April 15, 2020, in the amount of \$279,360.00 which shall**  
22 **be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S.**  
23 **Department of Justice for the continuation of this grant.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
26 **expend the FY 2021 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim**  
27 **Services Set-Aside Program Budget, provided that any amendments or**  
28 **modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
29 **Legislative Council.**

30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29<sup>TH</sup>**  
31 **day of APRIL, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**  
32 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
33 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
34 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; approved by the Acting Deputy**  
35 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
36 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
