

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the FY2020 Professional Service Agreement between the Tohono  
O'odham Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-127**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to consult, negotiate and  
2 conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with  
3 Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their  
4 departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or  
5 organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section I (f)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Professional Service Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation  
8 ("Nation") and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.  
9 ("Intermountain") will allow Intermountain to provide residential and foster  
10 care services for the Nation's Children In Need of Care for the period of October 1,  
11 2019 to September 30, 2020; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Professional Services Agreement is in excess of \$500,000.00, and so has been  
13 reviewed by the office of attorney general as required by law; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the funding for this agreement will come from the FY 2020 Department of Health  
15 and Human Services Division of Child Welfare Tribal Child Welfare Budget 001-  
16 20-6051; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the agreement and  
18 recommends its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
20 approves the Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham  
21 Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc. in substantially  
22 the form attached and authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairperson to  
23 execute and administer the Agreement.

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
25 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
26 expend the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Division of Child  
27 Welfare Program Professional Service Agreement provided that any  
28 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the  
29 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29<sup>TH</sup>**  
31 **day of APRIL, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**  
32 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
33 **Article IV, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
34 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
35 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
36 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
