

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Bureau of Indian Affairs Family Preservation Program Budget Amendment No. 2)

RESOLUTION NO. 20-128

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Bureau of Indian Affairs
8 ("BIA") Family Preservation Program Budget in the amount of \$234,849.00 was
9 approved by Resolution No. 19-300 and subsequently amended by Resolution No.
10 20-019 in the amount of \$272,838.50; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
12 review and approval its FY 2020 BIA Family Preservation Program Budget
13 Amendment No. 2, which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust
14 operational and/or personnel line items; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services BIA Family Preservation
16 Program Budget Amendment No. 2 will increase the FY 2020 BIA Family
17 Preservation Program Budget by \$66,925.78 from \$272,838.50 to \$339,764.28; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
19 reviewed the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services BIA Family
20 Preservation Program Budget Amendment No. 2 and recommend its approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22 FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services BIA Family Preservation
23 Program Budget Amendment No. 2 effective October 1, 2019, which includes a
24 \$66,925.78 increase from \$272,838.50 to \$339,764.28 that shall be funded by the
25 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, Bureau of
26 Indian Affairs.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services BIA Family
30 Preservation Program Budget as amended, provided that any amendments or
31 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
32 Legislative Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH day of APRIL, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


