

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment No. 6 between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Arizona Department of Economic Security and Approving the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Budget Amendment No. 2)

RESOLUTION NO. 20-131

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") Intergovernmental
8 Agreement ("IGA") between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Arizona Department
9 of Economic Security ("ADES") was approved by Resolution No. 16-212 for a period
10 of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020 which provides funding to the Nation for
11 LIHEAP on an annual basis in the amount of \$62,572.00; and

12 **WHEREAS** the ADES submitted LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 5 to revise the Case Management
13 Service Budget amount with an increase to \$125,000.00, which was approved by
14 Resolution No. 19-401; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the ADES submitted LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 6, which will increase the Case
16 Management Service Budget amount from \$125,000.00 to \$128,038.00; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
18 review and approval its FY 2020 LIHEAP Budget Amendment No. 2, which is
19 incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or
20 personnel line items; and

21 **WHEREAS,** FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services LIHEAP Budget Amendment
22 No. 2 will increase the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services LIHEAP
23 Budget by \$3,038.00 from \$125,000.00 to \$128,038.00; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
25 reviewed the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services LIHEAP Budget
26 Amendment No. 2 and recommend its approval.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:

- 28 1. the LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 6 to revise the Case Management Service
29 Budget amount to \$128,038.00; and
- 30 2. the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services LIHEAP Budget
31 Amendment No. 2 effective July 1, 2019 in the amount of \$128,038.00 that
32 shall be funded by the State of Arizona Low Income Home Energy
33 Assistance Award.

3 expend the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services LIHEAP Budget as
4 amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted
5 for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH
7 day of APRIL, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;
8 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
9 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
10 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
11 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
12 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
