

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting May 5, 2020 Special Session for a COVID-19 Federal Funding Update)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 20-145

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council**
6 **with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative**
7 **Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee has requested a special session on May 5, 2020 at**
9 **1:30 p.m. for a COVID-19 federal funding update.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
11 **special session on May 5, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. for a COVID-19 federal funding update.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH day of**
13 **APRIL, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**
14 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
18 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
