

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to submit an application for**  
**the Cares Act Indian Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat**  
**for Emergency Housing)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-193**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with  
2 the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,  
3 morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its  
4 members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally  
6 designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing  
7 Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-  
8 330, 110 Stat. 4016 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the  
9 Indian Housing Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate and expand  
10 affordable housing and supportive facilities; and

11 **WHEREAS,** Citizen Participation requirements have been met by posting information on the  
12 TOKA website and social media sites on plans to use funds and requesting  
13 comments; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the TOKA will develop infrastructure and purchase mobile homes for emergency  
15 housing on the Tohono O'odham Nation as it relates to the Cares Act ICDBG  
16 Imminent Threat application in the amount of \$1,500,000.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the TOKA  
18 is authorized to submit an application for Cares Act ICDBG Imminent Threat  
19 funding in the amount of \$1,500,000 and confirms compliance with the Citizen  
20 Participation requirements.

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs  
22 the Nation's Chairperson to execute all documents necessary for the TOKA to  
23 submit the application for Cares Act ICDBG Imminent Threat funds and any  
24 documents that may require the Chairperson's signature post award including  
25 the environmental review.

26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup>  
27 day of JUNE, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-  
28 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
29 Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
30 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
31 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
32 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
