

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Agreement
between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-220

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation ("Nation") with Federal, State and local governments.**
4 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Nation has negotiated a Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance**
6 **Agreement with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe to assist in the field of law enforcement**
7 **and aid the other Party when necessary; and**

8 **WHEREAS, this ("Agreement") will allow both Parties to detain and hold individuals**
9 **suspected of committing crimes in the other Party's jurisdiction until the other**
10 **tribal law enforcement Party arrives; and**

11 **WHEREAS, as needed each Party will share information on patrol operations, narcotics**
12 **investigations and all related criminal activities that may occur in each other's**
13 **jurisdiction; and**

14 **WHEREAS, this Agreement shall not be construed to cede any jurisdiction of either Party or**
15 **to waive either Party's sovereign immunity in any forum or jurisdiction; and**

16 **WHEREAS, this Agreement is for a term of five years and may thereafter be renewed by**
17 **further action of the Legislative Council; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed this Agreement and recommends**
19 **its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
21 **approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Agreement**
22 **between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation substantially in**
23 **the form attached.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation's chairperson or any designated official is authorized to enter into this**
26 **Agreement provided that any amendments shall be submitted for \prior approval**
27 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
29 **day of JULY, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
