

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-272

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2021 Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") Equal
9 Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC") Budget, which is incorporated by
10 this reference, in the amount of \$26,000.00 to be funded from the Nation's general
11 fund pending reimbursement from the Equal Employment Opportunity
12 Commission; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
14 reviewed the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
15 Office Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget and recommend its
16 approval.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18 FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Equal
19 Employment Opportunity Commission Office Budget effective October 1, 2020 in
20 the amount of \$26,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
21 pending reimbursement by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
23 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
24 expend the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
25 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget, provided that any
26 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
27 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
29 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**
30 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
