

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Police Department, U.S. Department of
Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School
Resource Officers Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 20-294

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
8 **approval its FY 2021 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing**
9 **Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant Budget, which is**
10 **incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$64,417.60 to be funded by the**
11 **Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the U.S.**
12 **Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program**
13 **School Resource Officers Grant; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
15 **2021 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice, Community**
16 **Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant**
17 **Budget and recommend its approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
19 **FY 2021 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice, Community**
20 **Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant**
21 **Budget effective March 1, 2020 in the amount of \$64,417.60 which shall be funded**
22 **by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the U.S.**
23 **Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program**
24 **Grant and FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Police Department Law**
25 **Enforcement Budget.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
27 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
28 **expend the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice,**
29 **Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers**
30 **Grant Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be**
31 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
