

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2021 Judicial Branch Amendment No. 2)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-165**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation... and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Judicial Branch Budget was approved by Resolution No. 20-250 in the**  
8 **amount of \$7,430,265.86 and subsequently amended by Resolution No. 21-046,**  
9 **which did not change the original budget amount of \$7,430,265.86; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**  
11 **2021 Budget Amendment No. 2, which is incorporated by this reference and which**  
12 **will adjust operational, personnel and/or capital line items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Judicial Branch Budget Amendment No. 2 will not change the original**  
14 **budget amount of \$7,430,265.86; and**


15 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2021**  
16 **Judicial Branch Budget Amendment No. 2 and recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
18 **FY 2021 Judicial Branch Budget Amendment No. 2 effective October 1, 2020, which**  
19 **does not change the original budget amount of \$7,430,265.86.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chief Judge and**  
21 **any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2021**  
22 **Judicial Branch Budget as amended, provided that any modifications or**  
23 **amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of JUNE, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
