

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham  
Nation and Apache County for Emergency Inmate Housing in the Apache  
County Adult Detention Facility)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-237**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**  
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**  
3 **O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments." (Constitution of the**  
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") desires to enter into an**  
6 **Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") with Apache County, which is**  
7 **acting on behalf of the Apache County Jail District under the Apache County**  
8 **Sheriff's Office for a term beginning October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021;**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, this Agreement shall automatically renew for three additional one-year terms**  
11 **unless either party terminates the agreement with a thirty-day written notice to**  
12 **the other party; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Intergovernmental Agreement**  
14 **with Apache County and recommends its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
16 **Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Apache**  
17 **County, substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman**  
18 **of the Nation to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**  
20 **Intergovernmental Agreement will be for a period of one year and renewed**  
21 **annually for three additional one-year terms.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
23 **Nation chairman and any designated official is authorized and directed to**  
24 **execute this agreement on behalf of the Nation, provided that any amendments**  
25 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
26 **Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>**  
28 **day of JULY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,001.4 FOR; -0-**  
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 216.6 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
30 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
31 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
