

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County, for and on behalf
of the Pima County Forensic Science Center, and the Tohono O'odham Nation
for Medical Examiner Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-401

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department desires the Nation to enter into**
8 **an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Pima County Forensic Science Center**
9 **for Medical Examiner Services; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council previously approved an Intergovernmental Agreement**
11 **with Pima County for Medical Examiner Services by Resolution Nos. 13-250 and**
12 **16-407; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement will be effective for five years from date of**
14 **execution; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Intergovernmental Agreement**
16 **and recommends approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Pima**
19 **County for and on behalf of the Pima County Forensic Science Center,**
20 **substantially in the form attached, and authorizes the Chairperson of the Nation**
21 **to execute it.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation approves the Intergovernmental Agreement from the time the Agreement**
24 **is signed by both parties through September 30, 2026, provided that any**
25 **amendments shall be presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**
26 **review and approval.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
28 **day of OCTOBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
29 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
30 **Article VI Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
31 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
