

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021-2025 Pisinemo District American Rescue Plan Act Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-099

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

12 **WHEREAS,** by Pisinemo District Council Resolution No. 22-P-08, the Pisinemo District has
13 authorized the Pisinemo District FY 2021-2025 American Rescue Plan Act
14 ("ARPA") Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of
15 \$2,983,501.00; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021-2025 Pisinemo
17 District American Rescue Plan Act Budget and recommend its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 **FY 2021-2025 Pisinemo District American Rescue Plan Act Budget in the amount**
20 **of \$2,983,501.00 effective March 11, 2021 to December 31, 2024, which shall be**
21 **funded by American Rescue Plan Act funds and which may be expended until**
22 **December 31, 2026, provided that the funds are obligated by December 31, 2024.**


23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021-2025
24 **Pisinemo District American Rescue Plan Budget shall be managed and expended**
25 **in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or**
27 **modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and**
28 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
30 **day of MARCH, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
32 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
33 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
34 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
35 **(48 Stat.984).**




