

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
Office Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-101

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section I(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
8 **("TERO") Equal Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC") Budget in the**
9 **amount of \$30,000.00 was approved by Resolution No. 21-316; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2022 TERO EEOC Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated**
12 **by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget Amendment No. 1 will**
15 **increase the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget by \$4,000.00**
16 **from \$30,000.00 to \$34,000.00; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
18 **reviewed the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget Amendment**
19 **No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office Equal**
22 **Employment Opportunity Commission Budget Amendment No. 1 effective**
23 **October 1, 2021, which includes a \$4,000.00 increase from \$30,000.00 to**
24 **\$34,000.00, which shall be funded by the Equal Employment Opportunity**
25 **Commission.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
27 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
28 **expend the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
29 **Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget, as amended, provided that**
30 **any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**
31 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**




