

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget to
Extend Budget period and Approving Budget Amendments No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-198

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget in the amount
8 of \$620,269.00 was approved by Resolution No. 20-197; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Economic Security Workforce Innovation and
10 Opportunity Act ("WIOA") Title 1B, Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") was
11 approved by Resolution No. 21-343; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Economic Security has granted the Tohono O'odham
13 Nation Department of Education One Stop Division an extended deadline for
14 expending the funds to June 30, 2022; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education has prepared and submitted for review and
16 approval its FY 2022 One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget Amendments No. 1, which is
17 incorporated by this reference, in the total amount of \$861,386.00 as follows:

- 18 1. PY20 Dislocated Worker, which includes a \$7,973.00 increase from
19 \$14,714.00 to \$22,687.00;
- 20 2. FY21 Dislocated Worker, which includes a \$31,789.00 increase from
21 \$69,761.00 to \$101,550.00;
- 22 3. PY20 Youth Adult Admin, which includes a \$2,614.00 increase from
23 \$6,912.00 to \$9,526.00;
- 24 4. PY20 Youth, which includes a \$99,150.00 increase from \$270,958.00 to
25 \$370,108.00;
- 26 5. FY21 Adult Admin, which includes a \$1,762.00 increase from \$4,736.00 to
27 \$6,498.00;
- 28 6. PY20 Adult, which includes a \$18,513.00 increase from \$40,089.00 to
29 \$58,602.00;
- 30 7. FY21 Adult, which includes a \$79,316.00 increase from \$213,099.00 to
31 \$292,415.00, which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items;

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1 **WHEREAS, the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget Amendments**
2 **No. 1 will increase the overall total FY 2022 One Stop PY20/FY21 Budgets by**
3 **\$241,117.00 from \$620,269.00 to \$861,386.00 for the period beginning on July 1,**
4 **2020 through June 30, 2022; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
6 **reviewed the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget to**
7 **extend it through June 30, 2022; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
9 **reviewed the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget**
10 **Amendments No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 12 1. **Amends the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budget**
13 **to extend the effective dates from July 1, 2020 ending June 30, 2022, which**
14 **will be funded by the Arizona Department of Economic Security Workforce**
15 **Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA") Title 1B, Intergovernmental**
16 **Agreement ("IGA").**
- 17 2. **Approves the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21**
18 **Budget Amendments No. 1 effective July 1, 2021, which includes a**
19 **\$241,117.00 total increase from \$620,269.00 to \$861,386.00.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
22 **expend the FY 2022 Department of Education One Stop PY20/FY21 Budgets as**
23 **amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted**
24 **for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH**
26 **day of JUNE, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
