

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets Under the  
Public Law 93-638 Master Contract)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-266**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Executive Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY  
8 2023 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master  
9 Contract, which budgets are incorporated by this reference, in the amount of  
10 \$17,872,432.48 to be funded by the Nation's resources pending reimbursement  
11 from the grantor; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the following base budgets in the amount of \$15,167,516.26 have been prepared

29 **WHEREAS,** the designated oversight committees for the respective departments and  
30 programs and the Budget and Finance Committee have reviewed the FY 2023  
31 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law 93-638 Master Contracts  
32 and recommend their approval.

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 2 1. Approves the FY 2023 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets under the Public Law  
3 93-638 Master Contract effective October 1, 2022 in amount of  
4 \$17,872,432.48, which shall be funded by the Nation's resources pending  
5 reimbursement from the grantor, subject to negotiation and execution of  
6 annual funding agreements with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- 7 2. Directs that in the event of a federal Continuing Resolution, the programs  
8 shall limit spending to only essential program services, functions, and  
9 activities; and the Nation shall seek reimbursement of all funds the Nation  
10 expends for continuation of Bureau of Indian Affairs Programs performed  
11 pursuant to the Master Contract.
- 12 3. Authorizes the Nation's chairperson or any delegated official to negotiate  
13 and execute the FY 2023 Annual Funding Agreement with the Bureau of  
14 Indian Affairs.
- 15 4. Authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated  
16 official to administer and expend the FY 2023 Bureau of Indian Affairs  
17 Budgets, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be  
18 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup>  
20 day of AUGUST, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
21 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
22 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
23 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
25 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


