

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting  
Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-271**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** Hewel Ni'ok has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2023  
8 KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant  
9 Unrestricted Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of  
10 \$230,258.41 to be funded from the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement  
11 by the grantor, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the  
13 FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
14 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget and recommend its approval.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
16 FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community  
17 Service Grant Unrestricted Budget effective October 1, 2022 in amount of  
18 \$230,258.41 which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending  
19 reimbursement by the grantor, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.

20 **RE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
22 expend the FY 2023 Hewel Ni'ok KOHN Corporation for Public Broadcasting  
23 Community Service Grant Unrestricted Budget, provided that any amendments  
24 or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham  
25 Legislative Council.

26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup>  
27 day of AUGUST, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
28 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
29 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
30 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
31 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
32 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
