

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Water Resources Department Southern Arizona Water  
Rights Settlement Act Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-283**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review and  
8 approval its FY 2023 Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act ("SAWRSA")  
9 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$2,034,374.64 to  
10 be funded by the SAWRSA Trust Fund; and


11 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY  
12 2023 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget and recommend its approval.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
14 FY 2023 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget effective October 1, 2022 in  
15 amount of \$2,034,374.64, which shall be funded by the SAWRSA Trust Fund.

16 **RE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
17 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
18 expend the FY 2023 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget, provided that  
19 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the  
20 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup>  
22 day of AUGUST, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
23 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
24 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
26 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
27 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
