

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2023 Sells District Gaming Revenue Budgets)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-338**

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
2 **Nation,**

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**  
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**  
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**  
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**  
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**  
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**  
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**  
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

11 **; and**

12 **WHEREAS,** by Sells District Council Resolution No. SD-78-22, the Sells District has authorized  
13 **the FY 2023 Sells District Gaming Revenue Budgets, which are incorporated by**  
14 **these references in the amount of \$4,500,000.00; and**


15 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2023 Sells District  
16 **Gaming Revenue Budgets and recommends approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
18 **FY 2023 Sells District Gaming Revenue Budgets effective October 1, 2022 in the**  
19 **amount of \$4,500,000.00, which shall be funded by the Sells District Account with**  
20 **Morgan Stanley Smith Barney.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2023 Sells  
22 **District Gaming Revenue Budgets shall be managed and expended in accordance**  
23 **with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and**  
24 **the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be**  
25 **authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by**  
26 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup>**  
28 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**  
29 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**  
30 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**  
33 **(48 Stat.984).**


