

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of the Grant Agreement and Approval of the FY 2023 City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) for the Native American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprises (NATIVE) Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-344**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation. . . and to appropriate  
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,  
8 negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono  
9 O'odham Nation ("Nation") with Federal, State and local governments."  
10 (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety Law Enforcement was awarded the City of Tucson  
12 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant, Grant No. HT-21-2966, for the  
13 Native American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprises (NATIVE) Task  
14 Force; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety Police Department has  
16 negotiated an Agreement with the City of Tucson HIDTA, Agreement No. HT-21-  
17 2966 which is incorporated by this reference, for the grant period of January 1,  
18 2021 through December 31, 2022; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety Police Department has prepared and submitted  
20 for review its FY 2023 City of Tucson HIDTA NATIVE Task Force budget which is  
21 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$17,282.00, effective January 1,  
22 2021 through December 31, 2022, to be funded by the City of Tucson HIDTA NATIVE  
23 Agreement No. HT-21-2966 and does not allow for Indirect Cost; and

24 **WHEREAS,** a limited waiver of Sovereign Immunity is required for the City of Tucson High  
25 Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Agreement No. HT-21-2966 to be enforced;  
26 and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the  
28 Agreement and FY 2023 City of Tucson HIDTA NATIVE Task Force budget and  
29 recommend its approval.
