

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Proposal and Appropriating Nation's Funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-366

1 **WHEREAS,** "It shall be the policy of the Tohono O'odham Nation to seek the return to the
2 Tohono O'odham Nation of lands and natural resources, including minerals and
3 water rights, within or adjacent to the Tohono O'odham Nation, or which
4 originally were a part of the historic Papagueria." (Constitution of the Tohono
5 O'odham Nation, Article XVI, Section 9); and

6 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "manage any
7 funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
8 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" and "by
9 law, ordinance or resolution . . . (3) to purchase or otherwise acquire property"
10 and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of
11 the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . with private persons or organizations on all
12 matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution,
13 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), 1(i)(3) and Section 1(f)); and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council has authorized the certain actions related to property
15 within historic Papagueria; and


16 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
17 recommend an appropriation and reservation of funds from the Nation's general
18 fund in the amounts and pursuant to the terms set forth in Exhibit A, which is
19 incorporated by this reference and shall not be reported or disclosed.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 21 1. approves Exhibit A, which includes an appropriation and reservation of
22 funds from the Nation's general fund in the amounts and pursuant to the
23 terms set forth in Exhibit A;
- 24 2. empowers the Nation's chairperson, or the chairperson's official designee
25 to undertake all actions necessary to implement this resolution; and
- 26 3. directs reports from the persons identified in Exhibit A to the Legislative
27 Council Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee monthly and to
28 the Legislative Council in closed session quarterly.


29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH**
30 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,436.85 FOR;**
31 **224.65 AGAINST; 556.5 [01] NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
32 **Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), 1(e), 1(f) and 1(i)(3) and Article XVI and Section 9 of the**
33 **Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on**
34 **January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
35 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
