

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit a 2022 Competitive
Indian Housing Block Grant Application for Construction of 18 New Low-Income
Homeownership Housing Units)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-375

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
2 Legislative Council with the power "to promote, protect and provide for public
3 health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham
4 Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally
6 designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing
7 Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-
8 330, 110 Stat. 4106 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the
9 Indian Housing Block Grant ("IHBG") and to seek other funds to operate and
10 expand affordable housing; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the TOKA wishes to continue providing new affordable housing for Nation's
12 members by submitting a 2022 Competitive IHBG application for \$7,500,000.00
13 and to leverage those funds with IHBG funds for construction of 18 new low-
14 income homeownership housing units to serve and improve the quality of life for
15 Nation's members; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Housing Committee has reviewed the 2022 Competitive IHBG application and
17 recommends its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

- 19 1. the TOKA is authorized to submit a 2022 Competitive IHBG application for
20 funding in the amount of \$7,500,000.00 and to leverage those funds with IHBG
21 funds to construct 18 new low-income homeownership housing units; and
- 22 2. the Nation certifies and confirms that it will assume environmental
23 responsibilities under 24 C.F.R. Part § 58.

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation's
25 chairperson, or any designated official, is authorized and directed to execute all
26 documents necessary for the TOKA to submit a 2022 Competitive IHBG
27 application and any documents that may require the Nation's chairperson's
28 signature post award, including the environmental review.


