

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 20-401, "Approving FY 2021 Executive Branch Bureau of
Indian Affairs COVID-19 Budget" to Extend the Budget Authority into FY 2023)

RESOLUTION NO. 22-378

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Executive Branch Bureau of Indian Affairs COVID-19 Budget in the**
8 **amount of \$2,701,890.00 was approved by Resolution No. 20-401; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the budget authority under Resolution No. 20-401 expired on September 30, 2021;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, to expend available funds it is necessary to extend the budget authority under**
12 **Resolution No. 20-401 to September 30, 2023; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the amending resolution and**
14 **recommends its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends**
16 **Resolution No. 20-401 to extend the budget authority for the FY 2021 Executive**
17 **Branch Bureau of Indian Affairs COVID-19 Budget to September 30, 2023 or until**
18 **funds have been exhausted.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
21 **expend the FY 2021 Executive Branch Bureau of Indian Affairs COVID-19 budget**
22 **funds for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2023, provided that**
23 **any amendments and modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH**
26 **day of OCTOBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
27 **~~-0-~~ AGAINST; ~~-0-~~ NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
