

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress of
American Indians 79th Annual Convention and Marketplace)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-384

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with
2 the federal government and other Indian tribes on all matters within the
3 Council's authority (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
4 Section 1(f)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the National Congress of American Indians ("NCAI") will hold its 79th Annual
6 Convention and Marketplace in Sacramento, California from October 30, 2022 –
7 November 4, 2022; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has worked closely with the NCAI and with Native
9 American tribes across the United States to address numerous national issues of
10 importance to Indian Country; and

11 **WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national-
12 level involvement in these issues by participating in the NCAI 79th Annual
13 Convention and Marketplace in Sacramento, California from October 30, 2022 –
14 November 4, 2022.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it
16 authorizes Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. to serve as the
17 Nation's voting delegate and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Chairman
18 Timothy L. Joaquin to serve as the Nation's alternate voting delegate in
19 Sacramento, California from October 30, 2022 – November 4, 2022 and at all other
20 NCAI meetings and sessions for the 2022-2023 term; provided that the voting
21 delegate, alternate, and any Legislative Council representatives attending the
22 NCAI 79th Annual Convention and Marketplace and other NCAI meetings and
23 sessions are authorized to present and advocate for resolutions and positions
24 previously approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
26 **day of OCTOBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
27 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
