

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 21-291, "Approving FY 2022 Executive Branch COVID-19
General Welfare Program Budget" to Extend the Budget Authority into FY 2023)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-398

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Executive Branch COVID-19 General Welfare Program Budget in the
8 amount of \$11,640,000.00 was approved by Resolution No. 21-291 which expired
9 September 30, 2022; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Executive Branch has prepared and submitted for review its FY 2023 COVID-
11 19 General Welfare Program Budget requesting to extend the Budget Authority
12 into FY 2023 which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust
13 operational line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Executive Branch COVID-19 General Welfare Program Budget
15 Amendment No. 1 will increase the Budget by \$7,343,800 from \$11,640,000.00 to
16 \$18,983,800.00; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2023 Executive Branch
18 COVID-19 General Welfare Program Budget amending resolution and
19 recommends its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends
21 Resolution No. 21-291 to extend the budget authority for the FY 2023 Executive
22 Branch COVID-19 General Welfare Program Budget Amendment No. 1 to
23 September 30, 2023 or until funds have been exhausted and to increase the
24 budget by \$7,343,800 from \$11,640,000 to \$18,983,800 to be funded by the
25 Recovery Funds.

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
27 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
28 expend the FY 2023 Executive Branch COVID-19 General Welfare Program Budget
29 as amended, provided that any amendments and modifications shall be
30 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of NOVEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


