

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
Program Cowlic Road Project Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 22-422

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
8 Cowlic Road Project in the amount of \$1,107,512.08 was approved by Resolution
9 No. 21-328; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has
11 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2023 Cowlic Road Project
12 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and which will
13 adjust operational line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program will
15 increase the FY 2022 Cowlic Road Project Budget by \$2,999,243.00 from
16 \$1,107,512.08 to \$4,106,755.08; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
18 have reviewed the FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department
19 Roads Program Cowlic Road Project Amendment No. 1 and recommend its
20 approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22 FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
23 Cowlic Road Project Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2022, which
24 includes a \$2,999,243.00 increase from \$1,107,512.08 to \$4,106,755.08 that shall
25 be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor
26 the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend the FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
30 Program Cowlic Road Project Budget Amendment No. 1 as amended, provided
31 that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by
32 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

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(Approving FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program Cowlic Road Project Amendment No. 1)
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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of DECEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


