

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
Program PIR 10(1) Fresnal Canyon Wash Bridge No. 662 Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 22-434

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section I(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
8 Project PIR 10(1) Fresnal Canyon Bridge No. 662 in the amount of \$90,000.00 was
9 approved by Resolution No. 21-431 for a budget term of October 1, 2021 through
10 September 30, 2023; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
12 submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program Project PIR 10(1)
13 Fresnal Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated
14 by this reference, which will adjust operational and/or line items; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
16 Project PIR10(1) Fresnal Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget Amendment No. 1
17 effective October 1, 2021, will:

- 18 (1) increase the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department
19 Roads Program Project PIR10(1) Fresnal Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget by
20 \$200,000.00 from \$90,000.00 to \$290,000.00 that shall be funded by the
21 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau
22 of Indian Affairs;
- 23 (2) incorporate Resolution No. 22-208 with the Nation's Tribal Transportation
24 Improvement Plan; and
- 25 (3) extend the budget period to September 30, 2024 to allow additional time to
26 complete project activities; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Agriculture and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have
28 reviewed the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
29 Program Project PIR 10(1) Fresnal Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget Amendment No.
30 1 and recommend its approval.

31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
32 **FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program**

Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2021, which will:

- (1) increase the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program Project PIR10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget by \$200,000.00 from \$90,000.00 to \$290,000.00 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs;**
- (2) incorporate Resolution No. 22-208 with the Nation's Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan; and**
- (3) extend the budget period to September 30, 2024 to allow additional time to complete project activities.**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program Project PIR 10(1) Fresno Canyon Bridge No. 662 Budget as amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of DECEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


