

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 21-389, "Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic
Development Department Roads Program BIA School Bus Road Maintenance
Project Budget" through FY 2024)**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-435

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Council") is authorized "to manage any
2 funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . , and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefits of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "(a)ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
8 BIA School Bus Road Maintenance Project Budget in the amount of \$61,227.69 was
9 approved by Resolution No. 21-389 in which the budget authority expired on
10 September 30, 2022; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Region Office awarded the Nation a no-cost
12 extension for BIA School Bus Road Maintenance Project to September 30, 2024;
13 and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program has
15 submitted for review and approval its FY 2023 BIA School Bus Road Maintenance
16 Project Budget requesting to amend Resolution No. 21-389 to extend the budget
17 period through September 30, 2024 to allow for available funds to be expended;
18 and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
20 have reviewed and recommend its approval of the FY 2023 Planning and
21 Economic Development Department Roads Program BIA School Bus Road
22 Maintenance Project Budget extension through September 30, 2024.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves an
24 extension of the budget authority for the FY 2023 Planning and Economic
25 Development Department Roads Program BIA School Bus Road Maintenance
26 Project Budget in the amount of \$61,227.69 through September 30, 2024.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend FY 2023 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
30 Program BIA School Bus Road Maintenance Project Budget, for the period of
31 October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2024 and the Accounting Office is



1 authorized to post the unexpended balances of the budget as of September 30,
2 2022 as a carry forward in the FY 2023 beginning October 1, 2022, provided that
3 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for further prior approval
4 by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH
6 day of DECEMBER, 2022 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;
7 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,
8 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
9 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
