

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting and Approving Amendment No. 3 to the Intergovernmental Agreement No. CTR055831 with the Arizona Department of Health Services Public Health Services Emergency Preparedness and Response for the Division of Community Health Services Public Health Emergency Preparedness)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-010**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vest the Legislative Council with  
2 the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on  
3 behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments  
4 and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,  
5 or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the  
6 Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Health Services, through the Bureau of Public Health  
8 Emergency Preparedness, has worked with Arizona tribes to improve the  
9 preparedness of each community in the event of any public health emergency,  
10 with most projects funded by grants from the U.S. Department of Health and  
11 Human Services Centers for Disease Control; and

12 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 20-241, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved  
13 Intergovernmental Agreement, No. ADHS2020-007, between the Tohono O'odham  
14 Nation ("Nation") and the Arizona Department of Health Services ("ADHS") for a  
15 Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program ("IGA") for the period July 1,  
16 2020 to June 30, 2025, which was subsequently amended by Resolution No. 20-445,  
17 and further amended by Resolution No. 21-413, which changed the number of the  
18 Agreement from IGA2020-007 to CTR055831 and authorized the IGA for the period  
19 July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; and

20 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has submitted for review and  
21 approval Amendment No. 3 to the IGA, which is incorporated by this reference,  
22 which will revise and replace the Scope of Work, the Price Sheet, Exhibit A, and  
23 Exhibit B; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed Amendment No. 3 to the  
25 Intergovernmental Agreement and recommends its approval.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and  
27 approves Amendment No. 3 to the Intergovernmental Agreement, No. CTR055831,  
28 between the Nation and the ADHS for a Public Health Emergency Preparedness  
29 Program.

30 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation's  
31 chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute Amendment No. 3

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1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement provided that any amendments shall be  
2 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup>  
4 day of JANUARY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-  
5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,  
6 Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
9 (48 Stat.984).


