

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Budget and FY 2023
Baboquivari District Cold Fields Community Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-037

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Nation,**

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Administration and Community Budgets in the**
13 **amount of \$3,932,391.66 were authorized by Baboquivari District Council**
14 **Resolution No. 2022-B-73 and approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 22-**
15 **353 and subsequently amended by Resolution No. 22-395; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the FY 2018 and FY 2020 District Mining Royalties were approved respectively by**
17 **Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 18-143 and 20-240; and**

18 **WHEREAS, by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2022-B-111, the Baboquivari**
19 **District Council has authorized the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Topawa**
20 **Community Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of**
21 **\$24,362.44; and**

22 **WHEREAS, by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2022-B-120, the Baboquivari**
23 **District has authorized the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Cold Fields Community**
24 **Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and will adjust**
25 **operational and personnel line items, but will not change the original budget**
26 **amount of \$457,612.39; and**

27 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2023 Baboquivari District**
28 **Topawa Community Budget and FY 2023 Baboquivari District Cold Fields**
29 **Community Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommends approval.**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:

- 1. the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Topawa Community Budget, effective October 1, 2022, in the amount of \$24,362.44, which shall be funded as follows: FY 2018 Mining Royalties in the amount of \$15,992.59 and FY 2020 Mining Royalties in the amount of \$8,369.85; and**
- 2. the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Cold Fields Community Budget Amendment No. 1, effective October 1, 2022, which will not change the FY 2023 Cold Fields Community Budget of \$457,612.39.**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2023 Baboquivari District Administration and Community Budgets, as amended, shall be managed and expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of JANUARY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
