

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Veterans Affairs Office Donations and Contributions Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-047

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Veterans Affairs Office has prepared and submitted for review and approval
8 its FY 2023 Donations and Contributions Budget, which is incorporated by this
9 reference, in the amount of \$42,013.60 in which \$41,513.60 is from the FY 2022
10 carryforward and the additional \$500.00 is a donation received which in part
11 placed in the Veteran's Affair Donations and Contributions funds; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
13 reviewed the FY 2023 Veterans Affairs Office Donations and Contributions Budget
14 and recommend its approval.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
16 FY 2023 Veterans Affairs Office Donations and Contributions Budget effective
17 October 1, 2022 in amount of \$42,013.60, in which \$41,513.60 is from the FY 2022
18 carryforward and the additional \$500.00 is a donation received which in part
19 placed in the Veteran's Affair Donations and Contributions funds.

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
22 expend the FY 2023 Veteran's Affair Donations and Contributions Budget,
23 provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior
24 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH
26 day of FEBRUARY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,730.7 FOR; -
27 0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 487.3[04] ARSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
28 by, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted
29 by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
30 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
31 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
