

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Sif-Oidak District Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-060

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2022 Sif-Oidak District Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration
13 Budget in the amount of \$907,990.24 was authorized by Sif-Oidak District Council
14 Resolution No. 22-002 and approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 22-082;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS,** by Sif-Oidak District Council Resolution No. SODC 22-189, the Sif-Oidak District
17 has authorized and submitted for review and approval the FY 2023 Sif-Oidak
18 District Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration Budget, which is
19 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$102,008.68 to be funded by FY
20 2022 Sif-Oidak District Mining Revenue Administration Budget carryover funds;
21 and

22 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2023 Sif-Oidak District
23 Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration Budget and recommends its
24 approval.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
26 FY 2023 Sif-Oidak District Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration Budget
27 in the amount of \$102,008.68, that shall be funded by the FY 2022 Sif-Oidak
28 District Mining Revenue Administration Budget carryover funds.

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2023 Sif-Oidak
30 District Carry Forward Mining Revenue Administration Budget shall be managed
31 and expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the
32 Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or

modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH day of FEBRUARY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by, Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
