9		FY 2023 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
10		Douglas Tyler Francis, Jr., Esq., to represent clients who cannot be represented by
11	8	the Nation's Advocate Program due to a conflict of interest; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Nation agrees to pay Douglas Tyler Francis, Jr., Esq., an amount not to exceed
13		Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00), in accordance with the terms of the FY 2023
14		Professional Services Contract, which shall extend from April 1, 2023 to
15	:	September 30, 2023;
16	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the contract and recommends
17		approval.
18	NOW, THERI	EFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19		FY 2023 Professional Services Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
