

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement
Program Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-259

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement Program Budget in
8 the amount of \$5,403,792.63 was approved by Resolution No. 22-266; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
10 approval its FY 2023 638 Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1, which is
11 incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or
12 personnel line items; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement Program Budget
14 Amendment No. 1 will increase the original budget by \$2,857,181.74, from
15 \$5,403,792.63 to \$8,260,974.37; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
17 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1
18 and recommend its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement Program Budget
21 Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2023, which includes a \$2,857,181.74
22 increase from \$5,403,792.63 to \$8,260,974.37.

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
24 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
25 expend the FY 2023 Department of Public Safety 638 Law Enforcement Budget as
26 amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted
27 for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH**
29 **day of JULY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
30 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


