

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Tribal Wildlife Grant and Approving the FY 2023-FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program Tribal Wildlife Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-263

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2 negotiate and conclude agreements...on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3 with ... local governments ... on all matters within the authority of the Tohono
4 O'odham Council"; "exercise the inherent powers to promote, protect and
5 provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the
6 Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
7 Nation, Article VI, Sections 1(f) and 1(c)(2)); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
9 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation... and to appropriate
10 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
11 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
12 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
13 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and Vegetation Management
15 Program was awarded the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Tribal Wildlife Grant,
16 Grant No. F22AP01262-00, the funds of which will be used for distributional
17 ecology of medium and large mammals on the Tohono O'odham Nation and
18 implications for management and conservation; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and Vegetation Management
20 Program has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2023-FY 2024
21 Tribal Wildlife Grant Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the
22 amount of \$200,000 to be funded from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Tribal
23 Wildlife Grant; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
25 have reviewed the FY 2023-FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and
26 Vegetation Management Program Tribal Wildlife Grant Budget and recommend
27 its approval.

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
29 **FY 2023- FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and Vegetation**
30 **Management Program Tribal Wildlife Grant Budget in the amount of \$200,000**

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
4 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
5 expend these funds for the period of June 26, 2023 to February 29, 2024 , and the
6 Accounting Department is authorized to post the unexpended balance of the
7 budget, the FY 2023-FY 2024 Department of Natural Resources Wildlife and
8 Vegetation Management Program Tribal Wildlife Grant Budget, provided that
9 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for approval by the Tohono
10 O'odham Legislative Council.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH
12 day of JULY, 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;
13 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,
14 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2); 1(c)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
15 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
16 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
17 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


