

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024 Baboquivari District Budget and FY 2024 Artesia Little
Tucson Community Building Project Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-368

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the
5 Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by
6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has
7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks
9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or
10 vice chairman of the district council.

12 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Resolution No. 2023-B-93, the Baboquivari District has
13 authorized the FY 2024 Baboquivari District Budget, which is incorporated by this
14 reference, in the amount of \$5,373,205.73; and

15 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Resolution No. 2023-B-95, the Baboquivari District has
16 authorized the FY 2024 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project
17 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$1,621,402.63;
18 and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2024 Baboquivari District
20 Budget and the FY 2024 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget
21 and recommends their approval.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
23 FY 2024 Baboquivari District Budget effective October 1, 2023 in the amount of
24 \$5,373,205.73, which shall be funded by the August 2023 District Allocation.

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2024
26 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget effective October 1,
27 2023 in the amount of \$1,621,402.63, which shall be funded as follows:

- 28 1) FY 2023 Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget
29 carryover funds of \$1,136,298.86;
- 30 2) FY 2019 Artesia/Little Tucson Community carryover funds of \$222,226.45;
- 31 and
- 32 3) FY 2020 Artesia/Little Tucson carryover funds of \$262,877.32.

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2024
2 **Baboquivari District Budget and the FY 2024 Artesia/Little Tucson Community**
3 **Building Project Budget shall be managed and expended in accordance with**
4 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the**
5 **Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be**
6 **authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH**
9 **day of SEPTEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
10 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
11 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
13 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
14 **(48 Stat.984).**




