

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program
Grant Agreement and the FY 2024 City of Tucson HIDTA Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 23-436

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements . . . on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
3 **with . . . local governments . . . on all matters within the authority of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Council" and to "manage any funds within the exclusive control of the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the**
6 **nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be**
7 **pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance**
8 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section I(d)(2), and (f));**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Public Safety was awarded the City of Tucson**
11 **HIDTA Program Grant, award No. G22SA0007A, Grant No. HT-23-2966, the funds**
12 **will be used for the Native American Targeted Investigations of Violent**
13 **Enterprises Task Force; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety desires to enter into the**
15 **City of Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement with the City of Tucson, for the**
16 **grant period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2024; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted**
18 **for review and approval its FY 2024 City of Tucson HIDTA Budget, in the amount of**
19 **\$17,000 to be funded by the City of Tucson HIDTA Program grant, Award No.**
20 **G22SA0007A, Grant No. HT-23-2966; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the City**
22 **of Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement and the FY 2024 City of Tucson HIDTA**
23 **Budget and recommend approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:**

- 25 **1. The City of Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement; and**
- 26 **2. The FY 2024 City of Tucson HIDTA Budget in the amount of \$17,000.00 shall be**
27 **funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council grants a limited**
29 **wavier of sovereign immunity in favor of the City of Tucson in order for the**
30 **provisions of the City of Tucson HIDTA Grant Agreement to be enforced.**

31 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
32 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the City of**

Tucson HIDTA Program Grant Agreement and administer and expend the FY 2024 City of Tucson HIDTA Budget, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH day of NOVEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
