

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2024-2025 Water Resources Department Water Revenue Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 23-452

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review and**
8 **approval its FY 2024-2025 Water Revenue Budget, which is incorporated by this**
9 **reference, in the amount of \$6,500,000.00 to be funded by the Water Revenue**
10 **Account; and**

11 **WHEREAS, any unspent funds from the Water Revenue Budget shall revert back to the**
12 **Nation's Water Revenue Account; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
14 **FY 2024-2025 Water Resources Department Water Revenue Budget and**
15 **recommend its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
17 **approves the FY 2024 -2025 Water Resources Department Water Revenue Budget**
18 **effective October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2025, in the amount of**
19 **\$6,500,000.00 which shall be funded by the Water Revenue Account. Any unspent**
20 **funding will revert back to the Nation's Water Revenue Account.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
22 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
23 **administer and expend the FY 2024 - 2025 Water Resources Department Water**
24 **Revenue Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be**
25 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
27 **day of DECEMBER 2023 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,263.3 FOR;**
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
30 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
