1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage, protect,
2		preserve and regulate the use of property of the Tohono O'odham Nation" and
3		"to manage or otherwise deal with lands, or interests in land" belonging to the
4		Nation (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(i)(2) and
5		Section 2(d)); and
6	WHEREAS,	on May 15, 1991, the Nation adopted the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority's
7		("TOUA," formerly known as the Papago Tribal Utility and originally established
8		pursuant to TOLC Resolution No. 08-70) "Second Restated Plan of the Operation
9		for the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority," as adopted by TOLC Resolution No. 91-
0		175 to plan, provide and furnish utility services to all areas within the Nation, to
1		acquire, construct, operate, maintain, promote and expand utility systems to
2		furnish electric, gas, water, sewer and telephone services within the Nation's
3		lands; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, promulgated amended
5		regulations at 25 CFR Part 169 Rights-of-Way Over Indian Lands, which provide,
6		in part, that an independent legal entity that is wholly owned and operated by a
7		tribe that owns 100 percent of the trust or restricted interests in land does not
8		need to obtain a BIA right-of-way but instead such tribe shall pass a resolution
9		authorizing access to the entity, without BIA approval, including a legal
20	į.	description, and shall submit both documents to the BIA for its records (25 CFR
21		§169.004); and
22	WHEREAS,	on January 18, 2017, the TOLC approved Utility Alignment Recordation
23		Procedures for TOUA, a wholly owned and operated tribal utility through
24		Resolution 17-032; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service (IHS) completed an arsenic compliance feasibility study
26		for the Oakum Kuk water systems under IHS Project TU 19-819 to address water
27		well arsenic levels which exceed the EPA MCL; and
28	WHEREAS,	IHS determined to address the high levels of arsenic is to connect the community
29		of Oakum Kuk into the Greater Santa Rosa Regional Water System (GSRRWS) and
80		replace undersized Ak Chin water main; and
31	WHEREAS,	this project was made possible through funds provided by the United States
32		Environmental Protection Agency; and

(Granting a Right for a Utility Alignment to the Tobono O'odham Utility Authority for Project No. 19-819) Page 2 of 3 WHERAS. 1 IHS will upgrade Ak Chin water main, from a 2 inch water main to a 4 inch water 2 main; and 3 WHEREAS. a new water utility alignment is planned for the Oakum Kuk water systems which 4 will connect the Community into the Greater Santa Rosa Regional Water System 5 through a main intertie; and 6 the new utility alignment is described as a 50 foot wide alignment encompassing WHEREAS. 7 10.70 acres more or less, which is more particularly described in Attachment A -8 legal description, and as depicted in Attachment B - survey map; and 9 WHEREAS. connecting the Oakum Kuk Community Water System to the Greater Santa Rosa 10 Regional Water System will be of substantial benefit to the Oakum Kuk 11 Community and their respective members because it will address water well 12 arsenic levels which exceed the EPA Maximum Contaminant Level; and 13 the Gu Achi District Councils have approved Project TU 19-819 through WHEREAS, 14 resolutions No. 0622-101; and 15 WHEREAS, TOUA has submitted a complete application to the Nation's Realty Office for the 16 approval and recordation of a new utility alignment as required under the 17 Nation's Utility Alignment Recordation Procedures; and 18 WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has reviewed and 19 recommends to the Legislative Council the approval of the planned water 20 distribution alignment. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants 22 to TOUA a right to utility alignment for Project TU 19-819, the Greater Santa Rosa 23 Regional Water System and the Oakum Kuk Community Water System Project 24 based on the submittal of an acceptable Application for Utility Alignment with all 25 documentation required by the Application and which includes an accurate legal 26 description in accordance with 25 CFR 169.102(b)(1), and a survey grade Map of 27 Definite Location, prepared in accordance with 25 CFR §169.102(b)(2) as these 28 sections may be amended from time to time, certified by a registered professional 29 engineer or an Arizona Registered Land Surveyor. 30 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tobono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants approval 31 of any encroachment permits for this project, including future individual 32 services installed on the system, which may be granted by the Bureau of Indian 33 Affairs pursuant to federal regulations to allow the utility alignment or service
