

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting February 27, 2024 Closed Special Session for Border Update)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 24-057

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures
2 to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees,
3 boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
4 Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vest the Council
6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative Rules
7 of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Agricultural and Natural Resources Committees have
9 requested a closed special session on February 27, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. for a border
10 update.

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets
12 a closed special session on February 27, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. for a border update.

13 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of
14 **FEBRUARY, 2024** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of **3,263.3 FOR; -0-**
15 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;** and **[03] ABSENT**, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
17 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
19 1934 (48 Stat.984).
