

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 24 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads
Program Santa Rosa Ranch Road PIR 35(2) Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 24-075

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 23 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
8 North Santa Rosa Ranch Road Budget in the amount of \$700,000 was approved
9 by Resolution No. 23-131; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program has
11 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 24 Santa Rosa Ranch Road
12 PIR 35(2) Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and
13 will adjust the professional service line item; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program will
15 increase the FY 24 Budget by \$100,000 from \$700,000 to \$800,000; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have
17 reviewed the FY 24 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads
18 Program Santa Rosa Ranch Road PIR 35(2) Budget Amendment No. 1 and
19 recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
21 the FY 24 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads Program
22 Santa Rosa Ranch Road PIR 35(2) Budget Amendment No. 1, effective January
23 17, 2023 through September 30, 2025, which includes a \$100,000 increase from
24 \$700,000 to \$800,000, that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
25 reimbursement for the grantor, the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA").

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
27 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer
28 and expend the FY 24 Planning and Economic Development Department, Roads
29 Program Santa Rosa Ranch Road PIR 35(2) budget, provided that any
30 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono
31 O'odham Legislative Council.






