3		all governmental departments, subject to the approval of the Tohono O'odham
4		Legislative Council (Constitution, Article VII, Section 2(e)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Appointed Officers law, 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, establishes the process for
6		legislative review of appointed officer appointments by the appropriate oversight
7		committee and approval or disapproval by the Legislative Council, and 1 T.O.C.
8		Chapter 4, Section 4003(B) identifies the documents and information required for
9		such review, including the current job description and the appointee's current
10		resumé, contact information, and a written background investigation report for
11		each appointee; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Appointed Officers law provides that "No person shall perform the functions
13		of, or be compensated for performing the duties of, an appointed officer for more
14		than 180 consecutive or nonconsecutive days without approval of the
15		appointment by resolution. The chairperson and Council may agree to extend the
16		180-day period by resolution." 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4003(G); and
17	WHEREAS,	on September 18, 2023 the Nation's Chairman Verlon Jose appointed Mary Ann
18		Ramirez as Interim Executive Director of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Office,
19		subject to the approval by the Legislative Council; and
20	WHEREAS,	the 180-day period for Mary Ann Ramirez to serve as Interim Executive Director
21		of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Office will expire on March 16, 2024; and
22	WHEREAS,	the March 13, 2024 Commerce Committee interview of Interim Executive Director
23		Mary Ann Ramirez was postponed until an updated Judicial Court background
24		check was obtained; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Judicial Court background check has been updated and so that the Commerce
26		Committee's interview may be conducted, however the interview will not be
27		completed before the expiration of the 180-day time period; and
28	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 1 T.O.C. Chapter 4, Section 4003(G) the Nation's chairperson bas
29		requested an extension of the 180-day period for Mary Ann Ramirez to serve as
30		the Interim Executive Director of the Gaming Office so that the Commerce
