

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting June 17, 2024 Special Session for Bureau of Indian Education
Presentation of 2023-2024 School Reports)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 24-161

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and


5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vest the Council
6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative
7 Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development Committee is requesting a special session be
9 set on June 17, 2024 for the Bureau of Indian Education presentation of 2023-2024
10 school reports.

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
12 special session on June 17, 2024, to be held in Council chambers in Sells, for the
13 Bureau of Indian Education presentation of 2023-2024 school reports.


14 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD day of
15 JUNE, 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,042.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
16 -0- NOT VOTING; and 220.5 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
17 VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
18 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
20 (48 Stat.984).
