

Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Chaperone Standards of Conduct

As a Chaperone for Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendant(s), I shall conduct myself in a positive, polite, courteous, and respectful manner at all times. I am required to travel to various events as approved by the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee. I am responsible for the safety and well-being of Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendants and therefore agree to the following:

I _____ agree that the following Standards of Conduct will govern my conduct during my time as a chaperone for Miss Tohono O'odham Nation.

1. I will, at all times, conduct myself in a respectful manner that does not jeopardize the reputation of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee and Tohono O'odham Nation.
2. I will be provided with a written itinerary of the event or activity, including a specific schedule with pick up times for Royalty, hotel, vehicle, airline or other modes of transportation, event schedule, and Royalty drop off time at home.
3. I will provide a report of any event that I chaperone, including any challenges or recommendations that could assist Chaperones with future events.
4. I will not consume or possess alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and inhalants, or tobacco. Exceptions are made for Traditional Ceremonies.
5. I will inform the Committee within a reasonable period of time if I am unable to carry out Chaperone duties.
6. I will respect and support Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendants. This includes holding the Crown or Sash when necessary during an event.
7. I will ensure that Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendant(s) are within sight and voice distance at all times.
8. If I am a Committee member, I will ensure that Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendant(s) do not use their personal funds to pay for any costs associated with appearances, including the costs of travel, meals, and any fees.
9. I will respect the traditions of the Nation and those of other cultures.
10. I will set an example for the Royalty by practicing good hygiene and grooming.
11. I will wear professional or traditional attire during chaperone duties.

12. I will only use hands free electronic devices while driving during chaperone duties to assist with navigation.

13. I have not been found guilty of, or entered a plea of nolo contendere or guilty to, any offenses under federal, state or tribal law involving crimes of violence, sexual assault, molestation, exploitation, contact or prostitution, crimes against persons, or offenses committed against children, or an offense involving dishonesty such as fraud or embezzlement.

14. I will immediately notify the Committee of any incidents or emergencies that may occur during my chaperone duties.

15. I understand that if I am to violate the above standards of conduct, I can be suspended and or permanently removed as a chaperone for the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee.

I have read and understand the Chaperone Standards of Conduct and agree that it shall govern me during Chaperone duties for Miss Tohono O'odham Nation and Attendant(s).
